## Vocabulary:

Pop Art - Art inspired by the pop culture of the 1950s, 60s and 70s. Contrast - A striking difference between two colours

Pointillism – The process of creating a picture using dots of colour. Primary Colours – Red, yellow and blue

Secondary Colours - Green, purple and orange

**Reduction Print** – Made by taking away (or reducing) part of a tile or printing block to make an image.

- Andy Warhol was an American artist who was a leading figure in the visual art movement, known as pop art.
- Andy Warhol's work involved repetition and patterning.
- Pop art was themed around common objects and famous figures in the 1960's.
- Warhol was called a pop artist because he made art about popular things, such as TV, celebrities, fast food, pop music and cartoons.
