- He was most famous for his elaborate wallpaper inspired by nature.

## **Alma Thomas**: (1891 - 1978)

- Alma Thomas was an African-American artist and teacher.
- She is best known for her colourful abstract compositions.
- She faced racism throughout her life.


In Year 3 you learnt what a reduction print is and how to apply paint evenly onto a tile using a roller. You used this skill to create a repeated print.


In Year 4, you looked at how light and shade is created with pencil and ink.

### Key Knowledge

Know that artists create work in a range of styles (impressionist,) and their paintings can be still life, landscapes, portraits or abstract.

William Morris designed patterns that were inspired by nature.

His wallpaper was handmade using carved wooden printing blocks. Patterns repeated and overlapped.

He used a range of muted colours.

Wallpaper designs can be categorised e.g. floral, or geometric, and can be textured.
