Attendance & Punctuality

Our recent attendance punctuality figures have been slightly below our usual high standards, and although there are often valid reasons, I must stress the importance of regular, punctual attendance for effective learning and attainment. Any absence affects the pattern of a child's schooling and regular absence will seriously impact on learning. Similarly, late arrivals disrupt teaching routines and affects the learning of other pupils in the same class.

Every half-day absence from school is classified by the school as authorised or unauthorised hence why the reason for any absence is required. The parent/carer of a child of compulsory school age is required by law to ensure their child attends the school at which he/she is registered. A parent/carer who fails to ensure his/her child attends that school regularly is guilty of an offence.

There is no entitlement in law for any leave of absence from school in term time. An application for leave of absence must be made in advance using the correct form (available from the school office and our website). Any request will only be authorised where school accepts there are exceptional circumstances. If possible, please avoid booking holidays during term time. Thank you for your support with this.
